Membership/Club Information

- Are you open to the Public: Yes, our Golf Course, Range, Golf Academy, and Grill are open to the public.
- What is the difference in Players Club and Legacy memberships?-Players Club does not have a free lunch included with each round, however, the monthly fee, and the fee to play is significantly lower Also, Legacy memberships have unlimited range use on days of play, and Players Club is limited to 1 large bucket daily (80 balls each=160 balls daily. Players Club and Legacy members may purchase up to 2 range buckets daily, any size, at \$0.94 (\$1.00 with tax) daily. Also, the Legacy "free" rounds, carry over for 30 days, and from November to February, they carry over for 90 days.

Please note that Legacy memberships are available on a space available basis as of March 1, 2021 -Inquire in shop for availability.

NOTE: All monthly memberships (Legacy and Players Club) allow reciprocal privileges at our 4 other area member clubs-see clubs on Players Club list below:

- What is Loyalty Club?- this is a discount card that allows up to \$26 off weekend Prime Time rounds, and \$15 on weekday Prime Time rounds, a free drink with each round, large discounts on hot dogs and burgers, and 14-day n advance tee times. There are no range privileges, or reciprocal Club benefits. The card is now valid through 2/28/2022 for those joining after February, 28, 2021.
- Legacy memberships have one free round, however, is there a discount on the greens fee I would pay on other days? Yes-see rate sheet (also on the "RATES" tab on our www.heritagegolflinks.com website) and reference the rates under the Legacy Bronze, Silver, Gold columns.
- Will I be assigned a member number or receive a card or something to use when I make my online tee times-Yes-You will receive a member card that is used for checking in whenever you register in the shop for your round of golf, or request range balls. Range balls are included in some memberships at no additional charge to you, and players must request at ticket in the Golf Shop. The range ball dispenser is located behind the snack bar next to the range. When redeeming free rounds, or paying a fee, you must come in to the shop for us to "punch" your card to designate a free round used, or to pay your fee, and to get a receipt for the starter. If not using a free round, you would pay the discounted rates on the attached sheet. We do not ever bill your card for anything except the monthly fee for membership. REMEMBER: we require 2 players per cart unless you are a single or in a 3-some.
- How will I make my monthly payment? All member billings are on credit card draft and your card on file will be billed on the last day of the month for the next month. No membership fees are pro-rated for any reason.

- Is there a time frame for commitment to this membership, what is the cancellation policy?-30 days cancellation notice is required and you can resign at any time with a notice-just email Kevin.Woodruff@heritagegolflinks,com
